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Dear Friends and Family,

I pray that you are staying safe in these strange times. Below I have included some guidance and clarifications to how Warde will be proceeding forward with phase 2 of guidance from the Department of Health.

As we implement phase 2 we will be doing this carefully and systematically. We are looking at setting up the hairdresser back in the building by the end of next week. For safety pre-cautions both the Assisted Living and the Skilled Nursing facility will have separate hair salons. We will also have to greatly limit the number of residents in the hair salon at any given time. This service has been long awaited and we are very pleased that our hairdresser is able to return after a long hiatus.

We will also be resuming outside visits and starting inside visits next Thursday. For inside visits we have been instructed by the state that each resident will be assigned only one indoor visitor while we are in phase 2. Outside visits are more flexible allowing up to 2 visitors at a time and the ability to change who is visiting. To be pre-screened and set up an appointment time, please reach out to our front desk. Pre-screening will be done by Deb Melville.

I preface that all of these changes and loosening of precautions have the possibility to be pulled back without notice. This would be a result of a positive COVID case or potential COVID symptoms of residents or staff.

As a reminder Warde has added a COVID-19 update page with key information specific to our community at <https://wardehealthcenter.org/covid-19-update/>. I would encourage you to take a look as we update the information on this page weekly. Facility wide testing will also be reported on this site.
