I hope you have all been doing well; we continue to keep you in our prayers. As cases start to increase in NH we continue to stay vigilant and monitor the situation closely. I have a few updates to share over the past week.

In Rockingham county we are currently facing a 3rd wave of COVID-19. As dictated by the department of health in NH we are currently in phase I. Unfortunately, this does restrict our ability for inside visits at this time. We are currently open for outside visits weather permitting. We are still offering the ability for window and video visits as well.

I would like to reiterate the following from last week's letter. As the holiday season approaches we continue to plan and brain storm ways to make these important days extra special. As we do not yet know what restrictions may be in place for Thanksgiving and Christmas, we are anticipating different scenarios. There is a very real possibility that visiting restrictions and quarantine protocol for 14 days when leaving the building will still be in place. We ask that you make your holiday plans with these potential scenarios in mind. As always if you have specific questions I would be happy to discuss individual situations.
