In Rockingham county we are currently still in phase I restrictions. We are currently still open for outside visits weather permitting. We are still offering the ability for window and video visits as well. Please reach out to reception if you would like to schedule any of the above.

I will note that many of our residents have been taking full advantage of the warmer weather this week and getting some fresh air. Our life enrichment department continues to come up with new and creative ways of keeping everyone engaged.

As the holiday season approaches we continue to plan and brain storm ways to make these important days extra special. As we do not yet know what restrictions may be in place for Thanksgiving and Christmas we are anticipating different scenarios. There is a very real possibility that visiting restrictions and quarantine protocol for 14 days when leaving the building will still be in place. We ask that you make your holiday plans with these potential scenarios in mind.
