I pray you have all been staying healthy and safe. As we enter the new year we stay hopefully optimistic. I have a few updates to share over the past week. We have been working diligently to keep your loved ones and staff safe.

As of today, we have had a facility wide COVID testing by the national guard. Last week's testing provided all negative results for both staff and residents alike. Additional testing will continue next week as the COVID rates in the community continue to be at such a substantial level. It is this level that dictates our ability to decrease or increase precautions in the facility. This includes activities such as visiting and community dining.

On January 6th and 27th Warde's residents and staff will have the opportunity to receive the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine. We have just been updated that this will also include all of the residents on the Assisted Living and Independent Living. This will be distributed during a clinic set up by Walgreen's Pharmacy on the Warde Campus.
