Vaccination Clinic: On Wednesday, April 8th, Warde Senior Living will be offering our Vaccination Clinic for the most recent vaccines from 10:30am-1pm in the Gathering Room. We are working in conjunction with Shaw's/Osco Pharmacy to provide this clinic to our residents, associates and family members. If you are interested in receiving your updated vaccine, please stop by reception and complete the consent form.

Projects, Projects, Projects! Project #1 – As you may or may not know, we are transforming our 2nd floor Assisted Living of 16 rooms into a Short-term Rehabilitation Unit for patients who need skilled nursing and therapy. The project is projected to be completed by the end of May, beginning of June 2026. Our Nursing Home license will increase from 32 beds to 48 beds and our Assisted Living license will decrease from 39 units to 23 units. Project #2 – upgrade to the municipal water system. Warde will be tying into the municipal town water line down by St. Matthew's Church on Route 111. This work should begin this Spring. We appreciate everyone's support, patience and cooperation as we continue to improve Warde Senior Living!

The Assisted Living Life Safety Survey resulted in one deficiency. Overall, across six surveyors and multiple surveys, Warde achieved excellent results. We are incredibly proud of our team's commitment to quality and regulatory excellence.

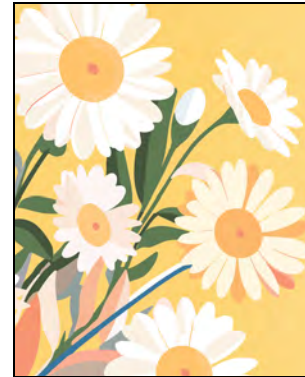
